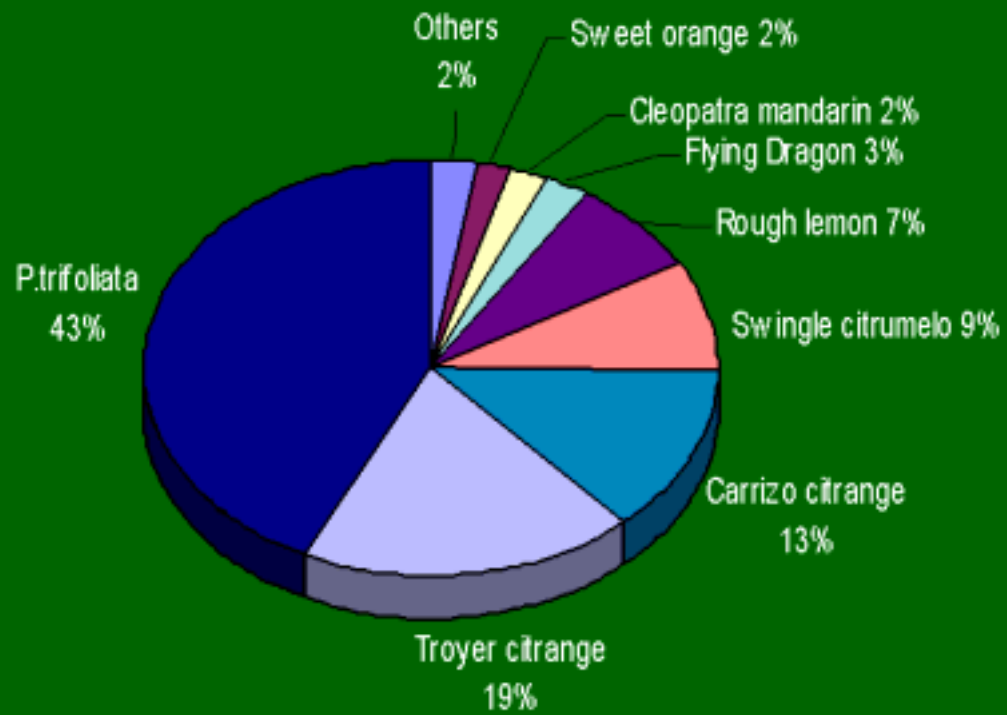

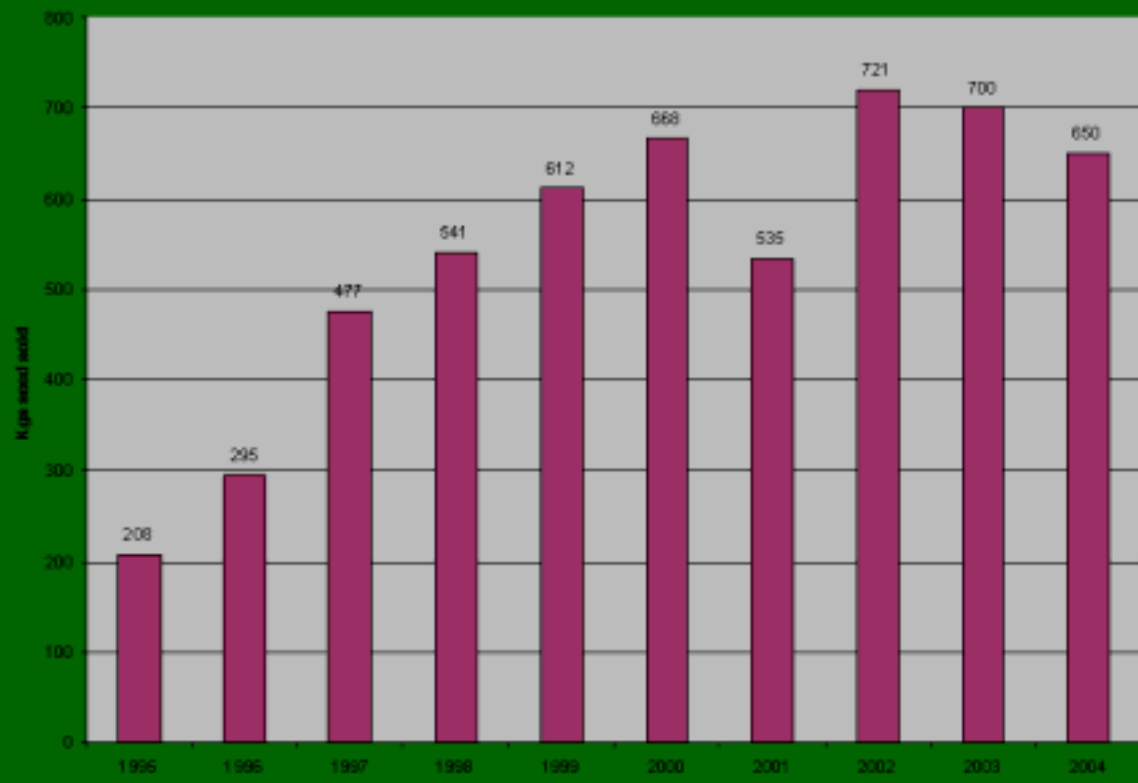
Historical budwood sales
