Irrigation and Fertigation

Management and practical aspects of conventional versus pulse irrigation and open hydroponics systems

Presented by Steven Falivene, NSW Citrus Specialist

Steven will give a preliminary update and discussion into the findings of a trial comparing open hydroponics to conventional fertigation methods. He will discuss the management and practical aspects of pulse versus conventional irrigation (differences in root density and irrigation monitoring results) and of proportional fertigation versus slug dose fertigation. Steven will also bring some preliminary sap flow and hourly fruit growth data and provide information on irrigating with saline water.
